##### *Taking Care of What We Have*

**Shoup Park** –The playground at Shoup Park is 24 years old; industry standards suggest replacing playgrounds every 15 years! This fall all equipment, except the mound slide, will be replaced. The park will be closed as of September 12 – playground equipment will be removed, our park staff will do some drainage and grading work and new equipment will be installed.

**Rotary Park** If you have driven by Rotary Park lately, you may notice a lot of dead grass and the field has been torn up. Our park staff has been working hard to make these athletic fields more playable. The front fields of Rotary Park are in a flood zone, and stay wet through most of the spring – there are many times when the fields are shut down due standing water. We have begun the process to regrade the fields – half the field will be complete this year, the second half in 2017.
