August & September Division Updates:

Parks

Shoup Park- Shoup Park will be closing beginning September 12 through the fall, into early winter, for some exciting improvements! Most of the playground equipment will be removed and our park staff will install drainage tiles and re-grade the area. The playground equipment is over 24 years old and replacement parts are no longer available.

What to look forward to:

- **The mound slide will stay**, along with the two toddler play sets.
- New play structure for 2-5 year-olds, another for 5-12 year-olds
- New swings, a zipline, and an OmniTri Net (great for climbing!)
- Rearrange playground layout for pieces to be closer together and easier to watch over multiple children
- Two shade structures and new benches
- Landscaping to create a natural barrier between the park and the street
- New fencing between the park and the driveway
