

Family Friendly Parks

1. Quality Parks and Recreation Facilities: Provide a variety of parks that take advantage of existing assets and develop modern facilities that serve as destinations for community recreation.
 - a. Make ADA improvements at park and recreation facilities in accordance with ADA transition plan
 - b. Replace playground at Walnut Grove Park (2003)



2. Improved Connectivity: Increase connectivity between parks, nature and the community
 - a. Replace pedestrian bridge at Stafford Park
 - b. Install paved perimeter walking path at Virgallito Park with neighborhood access to Coldsprings Dr.



3. Attractive Programs and Quality Experiences: Offer a variety of recreational programs and events for users of all ages and abilities.

- a. Seek additional partnerships (i.e. Tree Advisory Board, local universities, master gardeners) for 2 new additional nature programs
- b. Offer 2 programs specifically geared towards younger adults
- c. Offer 1 partnership program with Beavercreek Community Theatre



3. Attractive Programs and Quality Experiences: Offer a variety of recreational programs and events for users of all ages and abilities.
 - a. Make specific improvements to 2 events and communicate those to attract participation by individuals with disabilities
 - b. Add 1 new, recurring program that runs in the evening at the Senior Center
 - c. Combine the Garage Sale and Health Fair to boost attendance and increase the scope of these events

4. Effective Management and Efficient Operations: Utilize efficient, proactive management of staff and fiscally sound strategies to promote an informed population and a safe environment at parks
 - a. Create career development plan for all recreation and senior center staff
 - b. Update the employee training matrix and policy
 - c. Recruit 10 new volunteers in transportation
