# Financials

- Revenue: \$3,250,234
- Expense: \$3,215,586
- \$1.75 million revenue through property tax levy (1.2 mill)
- \$676k in grant revenue
- \$1.53 million expense from personnel costs



# 2023 Accomplishments

- Increased activities in evenings and weekend hours
  - Pickleball
  - Yoga
  - Meditation
  - Art & craft classes, etc.
- Over 2,100 members by end of year
  - Added 503 members in 2023



# 2023 Accomplishments

- 11,440 transportation trips in 2023 (9,000 in 2022)
- 1,435 wheelchair trips (977 in 2022)





# 2023 Accomplishments

- Event Highlights
  - Partnered with Police on National Night Out
  - Offered two children's entertainment puppet shows
  - Summer concert series welcomed over 1,700 people





# 2023 Accomplishments

- Program highlights:
  - Adult Softball Women's league offered for first time!
  - More summer camps than before with specialty camps
  - Variety of new classes and programs



# 2023 Accomplishments

## Spring House Park Master Plan

- Completed Master Plan with input from over 2200 participants
- Master Plan meets most of the unmet needs of the community identified in 2019 Parks Master Plan





# 2023 Accomplishments

## Improved Connectivity

- Hiking trail development at Cinnamon Ridge Park and Spring House Park
- Walking path at Gerspacher Park
- Bridge replacement at Merrick Park





# 2023 Accomplishments

## Park Improvement Projects

- Replaced roofs on all cabins at Wartinger Park
- Renovated ball diamond 1 infield
- Stocked pond at Dominck Lofino Park with minnows. Fish habitat being built by volunteers





# 2023 Accomplishments

## Park Improvement Projects

- Installed gravel parking lot at Spring House Park
- Landscape bed improvements in parking lot at Senior Center
- Planted 30 new trees
- Installed 700 yards of playground mulch at 9 playgrounds



# Volunteerism 2023



- Over 460 volunteers
- 30,262 volunteer hours
- Estimated value of \$962,332 (\$31.80/hour, Independent Sector)
